| <p><i>Outcomes</i> Identify how the “success” of this policy will be determined.</p> | |
| <p><i>Data</i> Examine the data sources (qualitative and quantitative) that have been identified to measure the impact of this policy. If you don't have data sources identified, assess whether and what kind of data can be used to quantify the policy's impact.</p> | |
